
Michigan Rehabilitation Services

Since 1944, the Michigan Career and Technical Institute (MCTI) has provided training for adults with disabilities in Michigan. Today, MCTI is the second largest comprehensive rehabilitation training center in the United States, human support services and state-of-the-art training.

The school is administered by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, a bureau of the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity, and accredited by the Council on Occupational Education (COE).

WHO ATTENDS MCTI?

Students who are 18 years of age or older can attend MCTI. They may be referred by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, Bureau of Services for Blind Persons, and private rehabilitation agencies.
