Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) are opportunities for students with disabilities to receive meaningful training and other services necessary to become successfully employed beyond school. Services are provided through Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS) with state and federal funds. Students can access services on an ongoing basis while enrolled in school.

HOW TO REFER A STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY FOR PRE-ETS?

- ✓ Students may receive MRS Pre-ETS upon completion of the referral, consents, and service agreement forms.
- ✓ Please remember to return the completed packet to your school.
- ✓ Fill out all forms using an ink pen.

STEPS TO ACCESSING Pre-ETS:

- 1.) Complete enclosed paperwork and return to school.
- 2.) Counselor will request a copy of student's IEP to verify disability.
- 3.) Pre-ETS may be offered as part of a school-based program or individually, as determined by school, counselor and parent.
- 4.) When your packet is completed and returned, your counselor will be:
