Dear Mr. Menzel:

I am pleased to inform you that the modification(s) to the Washtenaw Intermediate School District Plan for the Delivery of Special Education Programs and Services (Plan) have been approved.

The approval of your Plan modification(s) is an authorization for your intermediate school district and constituent districts to receive reimbursement under the State School Aid Act. This action has been taken on the assumption that your intermediate and constituent districts will provide special education programs and services in accordance with state and federal regulations. This authorization does not preclude the Michigan Department of Education (Department) from requesting clarification on items contained within your Plan as the need arises.

Your Plan includes optional programs and services under Rule 340.1832(e) of the Administrative Rules for Special Education, as revised on June 6, 2002. For students receiving such programs and services, allow for the disaggregation of student educational performance data, minimally that which is maintained on all students under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and No Child Left Behind (re-authorized Elementary and Secondary Education Act). This will allow the Department, the intermediate school district, the local school district, or the public school academy to evaluate the effectiveness of program and service offerings.
