"Skills to Pay the Bills: Mastering Soft Skills for Workplace Success," is a curriculum created for youth development professionals as an introduction to workplace interpersonal and professional skills. The basic structure of the program is comprised of modular, hands-on, engaging activities that focus on six key skill areas: communication, enthusiasm and attitude, teamwork, networking, problem solving and critical thinking, and professionalism.

This will be a great resource for not just teachers use, but parents, advisors, counselors, social workers and any stakeholders involved with youth in transition. You will find great activities that can be implemented throughout the school year as well as at home.
